### How to Get Here

**By public transport:** Bus number 261 from Naturno to Val Senales runs every hour and will bring you here. Bus stop: Unser Frau, Oberdorf 3 minutes by foot. (Local bus schedule: [www.sii.bz.it](http://www.sii.bz.it)).

**By car:** Take the SS3 between Bolzano and Stelvio, between Naturno Ovest and Ciardes turn into the Val Senales valley and follow the signs. Continue into the valley for 14 km (9 miles) to reach us. (Address for navigators: Archeoparc, Madonna 163, 39020 Senales).

**Parking:** Free parking for cars and buses. Two minutes by foot to the entrance.

### Regular Events

**Fire making demonstration:** Daily every full hour from 11:00 and 16:00

**Hands-on workshops – Archery, Grinding Flour, Baking Bread, Paddling a dug out and rotating short workshops:** Daily between 11:00 and 16:30, depending upon the program

**Tours:** Every Sunday at 15:00

No reservations are necessary for these events.

### Visitor Service

**Reservations for Group Visits:** During regular opening hours or in the winter from 9:00 – 12:00

**Cafeteria:** operates on days the museum is open from 12:00 – 16:40. For reservations, private celebrations or catering, please contact the Cafeteria team.

**Bookshop:** Opening hours same as the museum.

By Wheelchair or Stroller:

The museum and the open-air exhibition areas are accessible with assistance, reserved parking, no stairs.

Visitors with a dog:

We have a shady area in the Museum's outdoor area reserved for your dog. It is not permitted to bring animals along in your visit through the archeoParc. Please inquire at the counter.

Visitors with Difficulty Walking:

Both the Museum and the outdoor area have places for sitting along the visiting route
